For the 2018-2019 school year, Pathways in Education - Frayser earned an overall TVAAS composite score of 3. However, we did not meet the Tennessee Department of Education's Annual Measurable Objective Target for a decrease in below basic performance for both English Language Arts and Mathematics.

Pathways in Education - Frayser is working hard with the state and district to improve outcomes for our students. Starting in the 2020-2021 school year, we are implementing many new initiatives, including:

- Additional course offerings in our Small Group Instruction program
- Additional Literacy Intervention Courses
- Additional Math Intervention Courses
- Supplementary appointment times
- A full-time Intervention Program Coordinator on staff
- Participation in United Way's Driving the Dream initiative
- Technology support program for families
